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Hi CCS team,

Attached please find Crosslake Community School's most recent academic performance evaluation, based on FY23 academic data. The school earned 105% of possible points and is on track to be "eligible for fast track renewal" in accordance with Exhibit P of the charter contract. Congratulations!

As a result of the school's academic performance and its progress on the indicators outlined in Exhibit S (Performance Improvement Plan) of the charter contract, Osprey Wilds would like to offer CCS a two-year contract extension. This would bring the contract to five years, the maximum allowable under Minnesota state law.

Please let me know if the school would like to accept this offer. If so, we will need to amend the contract term in Section 12.1 of the charter contract and extend the academic goals, as well as address the outstanding revisions required based on MDE's review of the contract (bylaws, academic goals, and admissions policies and procedures).
