Teaching, Learning & Relevance

Current Work

- Forward Testing will be completed by all grades this month. We will also be bringing Tomahawk RVA students in to administer the Forward test to them as well. RVA students will have a different testing schedule than our students who are in the building.
- <u>Attached</u> is the Return to Learn Room and Behavioral Data for the 3rd Quarter, year to date, and trend data. Our Return to Learn continues to have a very positive impact school wide for both students and staff.

Current Work

- The YRBS survey had to be pushed back once again due to inclement weather. Students took this assessment on April 2nd.
- Therapy dog update
 - Our introduction to the therapy dogs, Red and Pyro, went very well. We will now begin bringing them in with different classes on a more regular basis. Mrs. Cerny is working with each grade level to coordinate times and classes for the dogs to visit.
 - Life Tools
 - Thanks for a grant from Marshfield Clinic, two sessions of Life Tools groups wrapped last month. The sessions help students learn self-regulation and self-esteem skills. Three boys and two girls participated in this after-school opportunity. These students were identified in areas of the BEST screener and Mrs. Cerny worked with their families to coordinate attendance at these sessions.
- 6th grade to STEM fest
 - The 6th grade students will be taking a field trip to NTC for STEM Fest on the morning of April 11th.
- Planning for the 5th grade transition to middle school is underway with our elementary students
- Current 6th and 7th grade students will begin planning for their classes next year with Mrs. Cerny later this month
- Raise Your Voice
 - Student leadership with be joining other youth from WI to learn about how they are working to end the stigma around mental health at the Mental Wellness Student Leadership Summit in Madison on April 11th
 - The <u>Raise Your Voice 5K Color Run/Walk</u> will be held on May 31st and it is open to the community
- 8th Grade Washington DC Trip
 - Final meeting for the trip will be held in May to go through final details for the students and parents
- Community Service Day
 - Students will be participating in our annual Community Service Day on the afternoon of April 30th
