Resolution for Disposal of School Property: Middle School Textbooks

The resolution below was brought forward for first review at the previous Board meeting. Materials are temporarily stored at the two middle schools until the resolution is approved. The Administration recommends the approval of this resolution so that the obsolete materials may be disposed of through a garbage or recycling service.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Oak Park School District No. 97, Cook County, Illinois owns middle school language textbooks that are no longer needed for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received an expert opinion that the surplus textbooks have no value; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to properly dispose of the surplus textbooks;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of Education of Oak Park School District No. 97, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

1. The middle school language textbooks identified on Exhibit A attached to this Resolution are declared no longer needed for school purposes.
2. The Board directs the Superintendent or his designee to dispose of the surplus textbooks as he deems appropriate by one or more of the following means:
 - a. Disposal in the garbage;
 - b. Distribution to children;
 - c. Distribution to nonprofit benevolent organization;
 - d. Sale at private or public sale
 - e. Disposal through a recycling service
