This discussion focuses on how we address today's growth challenges without overbuilding and creating underutilized facilities in the years ahead.

Initial analysis has led to a deeper examination of grade spans and feeder patterns, as these factors most directly influence long-term facility utilization and system efficiency. This review also prompts several additional planning considerations.

This long-range planning effort is intended to thoughtfully balance growth and sustainability alongside the district's current bond programs. By studying enrollment trends, facility utilization, and future capacity projections, the district seeks to develop the most fiscally responsible path forward.

The goal is to ensure that the decisions made today effectively serve students now while remaining responsible and sustainable 15–20 years from today.
