Recommendation: Approve the proposal submitted by the Texas Association of School Boards cooperative to provide the College with our General Liability policy, Professional & Educator's Liability policy, Information Security policy, and our Automobile coverage for the 2023 school year at a cost of \$60,444.00.

Background and Rationale: The College has used the Texas Association of School Boards for our liability and auto insurance for over 10 years. They have a very good understanding of the College's Governmental Immunity protections and what our "true exposure" is in such cases. That experience and expertise has saved us money on liability issues in the past. This year's premium reflects a decrease of \$4,667.00 from last year. Our liability insurance coverage limit is 3 million dollars.
