Proposal: Pathways Program Putnam County Primary School

Create a self-contained program in our district to provide comprehensive services for students with significant learning, communication, and functional challenges whose needs extend beyond the support of a traditional resource setting.

Why This Program?

- Students currently placed out-of-district could be served within our school.
 Provides a continuum of services beyond the resource level.
- Strengthens our legal compliance in meeting individual student IEP needs.
- Reduces tuition and transportation costs over time.
- Keeps students in their home community and fosters peer inclusion.
- 5–8 year old students will not have to be bussed over an hour one way to school in different counties to meet their individual needs.

Staffing & Services Needed

- 1 Special Education Teacher
- 2 Paraprofessionals (4 students) 5th student- consider hiring an additional para
- Full-Time Social Worker (will consider the need over time)
- Additional Related Services (can be served using current contractual services):
 - Speech-Language Pathology
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Physical Therapy

Student & District Benefits

- Individualized instruction for students with significant needs.
- Social-emotional growth through in-district support.
- Long-term cost savings by reducing out-of-district placements.
- Accepting students from other districts will help offset the program costs
- Stronger capacity to serve diverse learners making us more legally compliant than what we are now

Financial Considerations

- Investment: Teacher, paraprofessionals, expanded service providers.
- Over time, the program becomes cost-neutral or cost-saving.

Timeline

- October/November- Board approval
- December 2025 Hire staff, designate space.
- Winter/Spring 2026– Prepare curriculum, resources, family communication.
- Fall [2026-2027] Launch program.
