### BUS ROUTES-ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS - 2012/2013

In the event of adverse weather conditions, parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJO, KLDR, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the Three Rivers School District Web Page (<a href="https://www.threerivers.k12.or.us">www.threerivers.k12.or.us</a>) for information on school bus schedules, delays or closures. The district may also send a synervoice message to assist in communication.

Adverse weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel, but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you will need to bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.

### **Straight Line Routes For Applegate School:**

B-05 <u>Thompson Creek Road</u> - Pick Up/Drop Off will be at the bottom of Thomson Creek Road


B-06 <u>Missouri Flat, Kubli Road, Slagle Creek, Humbug</u> - Pick up/Drop Off will be where the right & left fork meet



### APPLEGATE LIBRARY NEWS NEW BOOKS ON THE WAY!


