Oregon 21st Century Schools Program

The Board supports the real and fundamental changes that are fostered by the "Oregon 21st Century Schools Program."

The "Oregon 21st Century Schools Program," is a program that encourages the restructuring of school operations by allowing teachers, administrators, other school personnel and the public working together to modify or waive or both, certain statutes, rules and local policies and agreements in order to promote greater flexibility in the way schools are organized, managed and financed. In exchange for such flexibility, standards of student learning and other educational performance shall be established. Clear and measurable accountability shall be provided.

To be eligible for the "Oregon 21st Century Schools Program," the district must comply with applicable Oregon Revised Statutes and rules to include a statement of support from the Board. At each school-level, an Oregon 21st Century Schools Program shall be established. If a district-level Oregon 21st Century Schools program is established at least one Board member to be chosen by the Board shall serve on the district planning committee if one is established.
