With Board approval, schools may conduct parent-teacher conferences periodically throughout the year. The time spent for those conferences may be counted as instructional time up to the equivalent of three full school days or 22.5 hours during a school year.

Proposed Policy

Issue Date: 4/14/16 Updated: 6/8/23

The amount of time devoted to Parent-Teacher conferences (or their equivalent) shall be part of the yearly district calendar. When the Board approves a yearly district calendar, they also approve of the amount of time devoted to parent-teacher conferences for that school year as indicated on the calendar. The time spent for those conferences may be counted as instructional time according to State Board of Education Rule. [R277-419-4(6)]. Each school shall conduct parent-teacher conferences on dates and at times that they deem best in order to facilitate this important communication. The amount of time spent in parent-teacher conferences will be the same as the instructional time missed due to holding the conferences.
