**Administrative Information:**

That the Wichita Falls Independent School District Board of Trustees recognizes **Wichita Falls High School Principal, Debbie Dipprey, as TASSP Region 9 Principal of the Year** as submitted and recommended by Michael S. Kuhrt, Superintendent.

**Explanation**

Debbie Dipprey, Principal of Wichita Falls High School, has been selected to represent the Texas Association of Secondary School Principals as a Region 9 Outstanding Principal of the Year. TASSP recognizes outstanding principals and assistant principals from the twenty region Education Service Centers in the state. School administrators are nominated and chosen by their peers within their regions. Nominations are based upon exemplary performance and outstanding leadership. As a Region 9 winner, Mrs. Dipprey is eligible to compete for the state title of Texas Principal of the Year.

Mrs. Dipprey has headed the leadership team at Wichita Falls High School since 2012. She attended Midwestern State University where she received her Bachelor of Science degree and Master of Education in School Administration.

Each of the region winners will be recognized during the Josten's Night of the Stars Awards Dinner on Tuesday, June 14, 2016, at the Hilton Austin Downtown Hotel. Each will be presented with an award and recognized in a commemorative booklet titled *Texas Principals, Texas Heroes*.
