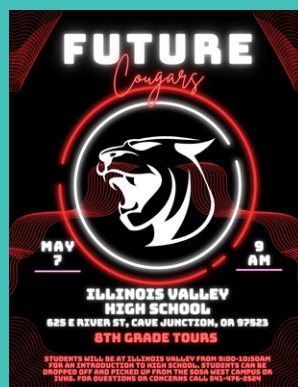
Enter the SOSA Art Contest!
