(HB3 Required Goal) D. **Summary:** Administration requested approval for the Design for Bid Package 1 for the Athletic Complex Project and authorization of the procurement of construction services for Bid Package 1 and the Board approved in December 2024.

Bid Package 1 is procurement of the bleachers, grandstands and press-box. These items have long lead times and administration is bringing the Board sub bids to receive approval of the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment for Package No. 1 (GMP #1) for the New Athletics Project in order to proceed with procurement.

Additionally, we are anticipating a presentation of preliminary design of the Athletics Facility to be presented in February and 2 additional bid packages with the final GMP presentation in April 2025.
