6 It is the policy of the Board of Education to appoint the most qualified applicants to 7 positions of employment within the Public Schools. The Board of Education shall be 8 responsible for the appointment of all building level and district-wide administrator 9 positions. The Board of Education shall make such appointments in accordance with the 10 procedures set forth in Section 10-151 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and in 11 accordance with any applicable collective bargaining agreement.

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The Superintendent of Schools shall be responsible for appointments to all other positions
requiring a certificate issued by the State Board of Education.

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17 Non-Certified Staff

19 It is the policy of the Board of Education to appoint the most qualified applicants to 20 positions of employment within the Public Schools, subject to the provisions of any 21 applicable collective bargaining agreement. The Superintendent of Schools or his/her 22 designee shall be responsible for appointments to all positions of employment within the 23 Public Schools which do not require a certificate issued by the State Board of Education.

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25 <u>Reporting</u>

26 The Superintendent shall provide regular reports of all teaching vacancies, leaves

- 27 absence, transfers, and new hires to the Board Education. Executive Session can be
- 28 <u>utilized as needed.</u>
