 - 1. <u>Business Operations/Resource Management</u> Ed Sbordone noted that this subcommittee met on Dec. 19th and reviewed the budget vs. actual expenditures. There are no major changes since last time. It is a tight budget year with the Special Education budget being closely monitored.
