Elementary Intervention & Academic Support Snapshot

Data-Driven Decision Making Our intervention process is rooted in a continuous cycle of assessment and analysis: **Benchmark Analysis:** We utilize recent benchmark scores to identify specific gaps in TEKS mastery. These "big picture" data points allow us to categorize students into tiered support groups. The cornerstone of our daily intervention is the WIN Time block Strategic Scheduling: This dedicated block is built into the master schedule for every grade level, ensuring that students receive support without missing core, first-teach instruction.

As we look toward STAAR, our intervention focus will shift to capture high-leverage standards: In March we will begin **Targeted STAAR Intervention** based on benchmark data and Exit Ticket results

Attendance Report

94% Attendance 01/26-2/26 - absences the first semester are attributed to illness (flu/strep).

Currently we are tracking attendance by grade level and competing for the highest attendance each month by grade. We also have a poster that is posted in the hallway with daily attendance recorded so all students and parents can be aware. Enrollment Report


Total Enrollment is 650 with variance day to day.
