Hello Middle School Parents!

We have one additional Student Health Survey (SHS) coming November 18, 2022 for 6th and 8th graders. The SHS is a collaborative effort with the Oregon Department of Education to improve the health and well-being of all Oregon students to help them succeed. Research shows that healthy students have better attendance, get higher grades and test scores, and are less likely to skip school, drop out or engage in risky behaviors. This survey will be offered to all students in the 6th, 8th and 11th grades and is completely anonymous. We respect parents' decisions and parents will have the option to view the survey (healthoregon.org/shs) and opt out in advance if they choose. Questions focus on student health and safety, student mental and behavioral health, and school climate and culture. Please look for the parent letter with additional details coming next week. Update From Salmon Egg Hatch Program

The salmon eggs are hatching! Your own Ms. Green was the first to see the hatch begin at Garibaldi. We now have a few alevins (newly hatched salmon) at both the Bay City and Garibaldi Libraries, with more hatching daily! Stop by and see how many you can count.

A little science tidbit for you: Eggs can begin hatching at around 38 days of age and 790 TUs. A TU is a temperature unit. The first hatch



at Garibaldi was at 857 TUs. Learn more about TUs and how to calculate them at the library! With

approximately 250 eggs in the tanks at each location, you should be able to see some hatching in progress if you stop by either branch within the next few days.

Cell Phone Use

Cell phones can be brought to school, but must remain in students' backpacks at all times during the school day. The phones should be on silent mode to ensure they do not disrupt the classroom instruction.

If a student is found with a phone during school hours:

- The first time, the phone is brought to the office. The student can pick it up at the end of the day.
- The second time, the phone will remain in the office until a parent picks it up.
- The third time, the phone remains in the office until further notice.

We have gone over this rule several times with students, but it would be great if you shared this with your student too. We have found middle school students need to hear things several times before it gets stuck in their head!

The Neah-Kah-Nie School District believes regular school attendance is essential for a student's success in school. Attendance is an area we focus on in order to improve student achievement and ensure all students at Neah-Kah-Nie Schools have the opportunity to maximize their potential.

The district has a new attendance protocol with a dedicated team at each school to:

- Assist families and students in improving student attendance.
- Reduce chronic absenteeism.
- Multi-tiered Attendance Team: Parents, Teachers, Secretary, Principal, Family Resource Coordinator (FRC), Counselor, ESL & Special Education staff.

We encourage families to help your child build the habit of good Attendance

- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day.
- · Help your children maintain daily routines, such as finishing homework and getting a good night's sleep.
- Try to schedule medical appointments and extended trips when school isn't in session
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, school counselors and other parents for advice on how
 to make your child feel comfortable and excited about learning.
- Seek help from school staff and other parents or community agencies, if you need support.
