Paid Lunch Equity Exemption Form Available for SY 22-23

As of May 2, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has not released the Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) guidance or tool for School Year 2022-23. While the tools and guidance have not been released, School Food Authorities (SFAs) with an even or positive balance will not be required to increase lunch prices for School Year 2022-23. A form is required for the exemption.

USDA Memo SP 08-2022, CACFP 07-2022, SFSP 03-2022 states in Section 752, of Division A of the Appropriations Act, that any SFA with a positive or zero balance in its nonprofit school food service account as of Dec. 31, 2021, is exempt from PLE pricing requirements found at 7 CFR 210.14(e) for School Year 2022-23. SFAs that had a negative balance in the nonprofit school food service account as of Dec. 31, 2021, must follow PLE requirements when establishing their prices for paid lunches in SY 2022-23.

To be considered for the exemption for School Year 2022-23, SFAs will need to submit the <u>SY</u> <u>22-23 Exemption Form</u>, which includes instructions. Please scan the completed and signed form and email it to <u>pleexemption@isbe.net</u>. PLE exemption forms cannot be used for corrective action plans. Failure to submit an exemption form will require SFA to maintain a Paid Lunch Equity tool for the upcoming school year. Be sure to maintain a copy for your records.
