High School 10 Year Life Safety Review

BLDD will be conducting the 10 year survey on July 22nd. I will present the report to the Board as soon as I receive and review it.

Lake Land 10 Year Life Safety Proposal

BLDD has presented a proposal to do a 10 year survey at a cost of \$4,000.00. They have also included a fee for mileage billed at 1.10 times the amount invoiced to the Architect. This will be billed separately. We have never done a survey on this building before and with our students using the facility and the District owning the building it is our responsibility to get this done. Mr. Bauer has talked with the ROE and confirmed this.

High School Roof

The roof has been completed at the high school. The cost was \$56,131.00. The maintenance grant that I applied for has been received for \$28,065.50 to cover half the cost.

Field Capacity and Gym

With the new capacity rules that are in place now, I wanted to make you aware of our seating capacity in our gyms as well as the football field. The high school gym is 1600. The Jr. High is 1035 and the field is 2000. With 20% capacity this is 320 people at the high school, 207 for the Jr. High and 400 at the football field.

Cleaning Procedures

With hopes of returning to school this fall we will be needing to increase our cleaning procedure. I'm not sure if our staff will be able to keep up with this, so we may have to utilize our sub custodians a little more.

Water Fountains

We have purchased 11 new bottle filling stations for the schools. These will allow students to bring their own bottle to school to fill from these stations with the hopes of limiting the touching of water fountains. We will have 3 at the high school, 3 at each elementary schools and 2 at the Jr.high.

Lincoln School Tuck Pointing

This work is almost complete as of today July20th. Once it is done I will be able to repair the damage done to the inside wall. All work will be done before we return to school.

Transportation

New buses are here

The 2 new buses have arrived and we have put radios and cameras in and they are ready to be put in the fleet for this year.

Craig Deering new hire

Craig has completed his initial course and since he already has his CDL he is ready to be a sub driver for us. I believe he will be on the list of employees to be approved tonight. Craig recently moved here from up north where he drove for another school district.

With all the new rules sent out from ISBE we are going to start out the new year with a lot of unknowns. With the riders being limited to 50 per bus and the assignment of seats we will have to use most if not all of our buses this year. I am not sure at this time how we will handle these changes. I do believe that we will probably be using all our sub drivers on a daily basis to help with the over flow of students as a bus becomes full. We will be working on this plan over the next few weeks as registration begins and we see how many students will be riding.
