

West Allis - West Milwaukee District Medal Totals:

- West Allis Central High School earned 137 gold, 36 silver, 2 bronze for a total of 175 medals
- West Allis Nathan Hale High School earned 226 gold, 50 silver & 1 bronze for a total of 277 medals
- Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate School earned 191 gold, 85 silver, & 0 bronze totaling 276 medals
- West Milwaukee Intermediate School earned 4 gold, 19 silver, & 0 bronze for a total
 of 23 medals


West Milwaukee Intermediate School
