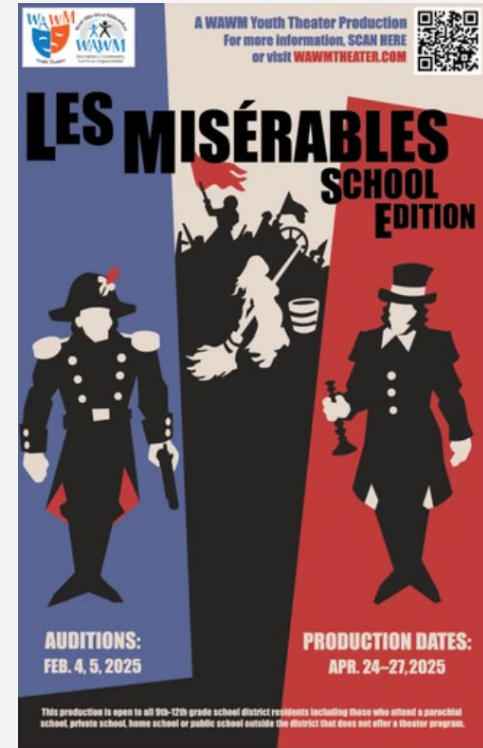

District Solo & Ensemble Music Festival

West Allis - West Milwaukee District Medal Totals:

- **West Allis Central High School** earned 137 gold, 36 silver, 2 bronze for a total of 175 medals
- **West Allis Nathan Hale High School** earned 226 gold, 50 silver & 1 bronze for a total of 277 medals
- **Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate School** earned 191 gold, 85 silver, & 0 bronze totaling 276 medals
- **West Milwaukee Intermediate School** earned 4 gold, 19 silver, & 0 bronze for a total of 23 medals

Note: Dottke's medal count is included with Hale & Central as those students are dual-enrolled.

The District Total Medal Count was 558 gold, 190 silver, 3 bronze equalling 751 medals.
