7. "HAND SEAL" OF SIMILAR FLEXIBLE-TYPE JOINTS SHALL BE USED IN THE CONNECTION OF SEWER PIPES OF DISSIMILAR MATERIALS.
8. WHEN CONNECTING TO AN EXISTING SEWER MAIN BY MEANS OTHER THAN AN EXISTING MANHOLE, THE EXISTING MANHOLE, ONE OF THE FOLLOWING METHODS SHALL BE USED:
 1. CIRCULAR SAW-CUT OF 18" MAIN BY PROPER TOOLS (POWERED TAP MACHINE OR SIMILAR) AND PROPER INSTALLATION OF MURPHY'S GASKET OR HIGH-TENSILE GASKET.
 2. REMOVE AN ENTIRE SECTION OF PIPE (BREAKING ONLY THE TOP OF ONE RELL) AND REPLACE WITH A NEW ONE OF THE SAME SECTION.
 3. WITH PIPE CUTTER, NEATLY AND ACCURATELY CUT OUT DESIRED LENGTH OF PIPE FOR POSITION OF PROPOSED FITTING, USING "HAND SEAL" OR SIMILAR SUBSTANCE TO HOLD IT FIRMLY IN PLACE.
9. WHENEVER A SANITARY/COMBINED SEWER CROSSES UNDER A WATERMAIN, THE MINIMUM VERTICAL DISTANCE FROM THE TOP OF THE SEWER TO THE BOTTOM OF THE WATERMAIN SHALL BE 18" MINIMUM. FURTHERMORE, A MINIMUM HORIZONTAL DISTANCE OF 10 FEET BETWEEN SANITARY/COMBINED SEWERS AND WATERMAINS SHALL BE MAINTAINED UNLESS THE SEWER IS Laid IN A SEPARATE TRENCH, KEEPING A MINIMUM 18" VERTICAL SEPARATION. IF THE SEWER IS Laid IN THE SAME TRENCH WITH THE WATERMAIN LOCATED AT THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF A RICH OF UNDISTURBED EARTH, KEEPING A MINIMUM 18" VERTICAL SEPARATION. IF THE VERTICAL OR HORIZONTAL DISTANCES DESCRIBED ABOVE CAN NOT BE MAINTAINED, OR THE SEWERS CROSSES ABOVE THE WATERMAIN, THE SEWER SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED TO DISCHARGE INTO THE WATERMAIN.
10. ALL EXISTING SEPTIC SYSTEMS SHALL BE ABANDONED. ABANDONED TANKS SHALL BE FILLED WITH GRANULAR MATERIAL OR REMOVED.
11. ALL SANITARY MANHOLES, (AND STORM MANHOLES IN COMBINED SEWER AREAS) SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM INSIDE DIAMETER OF 48" INCHES, AND SHALL BE CAST IN PLACE OF PRE-CAST REINFORCED CONCRETE.
