D. Seasonal Layoffs, Gary Kawlewski, Director of Finance and Operations Be it resolved, the Board of Education of ISD 877 Buffalo-Hanover-Montrose Schools approves seasonal leaves of absence to district employees who work in school-year positions less than twelve months a year, such leave being from the time they complete their 2015-2016 duties until the scheduled return to work for the 2016-2017 school year. Positions include food service personnel, education support professionals, clerical staff and other non-affiliated school year employees.

 E. Substitute Pay Rates, Gary Kawlewski, Director of Finance and Operations Recommendation is to increase the substitute pay rates for custodians, clerical and ESPs from \$11.25 to \$11.55. Comparisons are made with neighboring districts. Fill rates for ESPs are at 86% and can be challenging to fill.

F. Superintendent Evaluation/2016-19 Contract, Dave Wilson, Chair An annual review was conducted on May 9th. Some of the performance qualities noted were: highly regarded by his peers, possesses good problem solving and leadership skills, keen to areas of strategic awareness and change management, responsive to the concerns of the Board and communicates issues facing the school district. New three-year contract is recommended with slight language revisions and an increase in salary.

A. Out-of-State Trip - Girls Swim/Dive to Iowa, Rachel Busch, Head Coach This is the third annual trip for the girls swim and dive team. May look at a different location that is in state due to cost. Will continue to plan.

Discussion: Transportation is the most costly piece at \$3000. Given the name of Holt Bus Company for a comparison.

Board gave preliminary approval.

B. BHS MN Transfer Curriculum Presentation, Mark Mischke, BHS Principal Christina Cox, Counselor at BHS provided the board with information about the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum program being offered at BHS starting with the 2016-17 school year. The program will expand the access for more students to participate in college-level coursework classes and produce students who are career and college ready. This program provides the students with the classes students usually take during their first two years of college, referred to as "generals". Partnerships are with U of M, St. Cloud State, NHCC, HTC and Southwest Minnesota State. Forty credits are offered over ten goal areas along with 15 electives. The process of credentialing of teachers continues as new classes and staff are added. Cost savings to families last year was \$718,000 for students who earned a total of 2429 credits.

Discussion: Most credits also transfer to private colleges. College level classes are also provided at the ninth and tenth grade levels. Huge benefit is the students' head start at a college career and experience with the rigor of college level classes.
