#### K-8 Science

Classification and characteristics.... Are our themes for the year in Science. We have Begun our unit of study on Plants and Seeds.

In addition to academic activities, they will be starting indoor flower gardens to beautify our school and organic window sill spice gardens that will be for sale when they are ready. This will combine the math concepts of money and budgeting with the social studies economics concepts.

We are continuing our animal care projects and have expanded them to include a dozen rare Icelandic chicks. We still gather and sell eggs, however with the onset of Winters limited sunshine and some molting, we are not gathering a whole lot. ### Social Studies 5-8

Our students are continuing to explore the theme of migration through fictional literature and our World Explorers Unit.

We are continuing our journey with Maura (the 15 year old main character) in the book <u>Follow The Western Sea</u>. We are closely examining the treatment and prejudices against the Irish immigrants and comparing them to other groups over time through today. We have begun incorporating the study historic and modern political cartoons as a means of understanding the issues of Immigration over time.

### High School Health
