## **Consolidated Federal and State Grants Application**

The district's submission of the Consolidated Federal and State Grant Application (CFSGA) is due August 31. This application outlines our planned use of federal and state dollars for the coming year. A large portion of each program is dedicated to staffing classified and certified staff within the three buildings. Our preliminary awards have been adjusted slightly over the last month.

Our preliminary grant awards:

Title I-A, Improving Basic Programs - \$300,726 Title I-C, Education of Migratory Children- \$74,992 Title II-A, Supporting Effective Instruction - \$45,586 Title III-A, English Language Acquisition - \$18,241 State English Learner Program - \$40,258 Title IV-A Student Support and Academic Enrichment- \$24,860 Title V-B Rural Education Program- \$21,571 Final figures are typically available in October.

We have seen an increase in our State English Learner program funding as a reflection of an increase in our EL population as well as an overall increase of state funding to this program.

## **Migrant Summer School**

Homedale/ Marsing Joint Summer School was a success again this year. We had 70 students ranging from 3 years of age to 6th grade participate in the program. Due to our migrant funding cuts we were only able to run a two week program with half days. We have again seen a decrease in migrant funding for the 2018-2019 school year. This could have further impacts on summer school.
