
It currently indicates that our building has 719 total parent respondents. With 3rd graders included, we only have 257 total students. It would appear that our total number of parents is incorrect. UChicago has been contacted and ISBE has been notified of the incorrect parent counts. They expect to receive updated counts from them in the next two weeks.

<u>Students</u>: The reporting threshold of 50% for this survey. Lincoln Elementary has currently reached 25% as of 2/18/21.




