PD planning and Leadership Week

The majority of the PD for the year will be planned along with establishing an School Leadership Team

Babb during SBE picked 4 focus points for the 21-22 school year. The focus points are: 1) Writing, 2) Math (Mary Buck plan), 3) DESSA (SEL), and (4 Science and Social Studies curriculum. The building specific focus points will center around our academic and SEL focus points. These 4 focus points will guide the planning and support provided by myself and the SLT.

Babb will be implementing fully a School Leadership Team for the 21-22 school year supported by an action plan, strategic plan, and instructional framework. The SLT that was in place will be built upon and these supports will be added which will allow the staff to articulate the goals we have set and use these goals to guide their performance on a daily basis.

In reflecting on the 20-21 school year our data is giving us an opportunity to move in a



different direction when it comes to our instructional framework. We have an opportunity to build upon the current instructional framework that is based upon Culturally Responsive Teaching that uses Project Based learning and a whole child curriculum to give our students a challenging, yet supportive education that can and will meet our students where they are at.

Babb will be producing the same deliverables as the other buildings in the district in an attempt to better align what we do in Babb with what is done in the rest of the district. Registration will be on August 10th from 10am-3pm and we are looking forward to the 21-22 school year.

LEADERSHIP WEEK & AUGUST PD

Leadership Week will be used to refine our instructional framework and develop our School Leadership Team (SLT).
