Spring Assessment Results ACT/PreACT Results

All freshman, sophomore, and junior students took the ACT or PreACT for the first time this past April. Freshman took the PreACT 9, sophomores took the PreACT, and juniors took the ACT. The results below show the % of students that meet ACT benchmarks for their respective exam. MCHS administration and staff have reviewed the results and are using the data to plan for instruction and ACT prep options for the 2025-2026 school year.

AP Exams

AP score reports were released to students and families and schools July 7th. MCHS had 621 students take 1,054 exams over a two week period in May. Of the 621 students taking exams, 495 (80%) scored a 3 or higher on the exam (passing score). A score of 3 or higher will result in potential college credit for a student. This is the highest number of students receiving passing scores in the past five years. This is a direct result of our students' hard work and our teachers' dedication to preparing students for their AP exams.
