6. REPORTS

A. Census/Enrollment Projections/Enrollment Options, Gary Kawlewski, Director of Finance and Operations

Enrollment peaked in 2008-09 and then stayed relatively flat and have been declining slightly in recent years. October 1st enrollment count is used for projections. We lose more students than we gain through Open Enrollment. 267 resident students attend Salem or St. Francis nonpublic schools, which is an increase of 5 students from last year. Historically, our K-12 enrollment decreases during the year mainly at the high school level and in part due to early graduation and PSEO options. The Schoolfinances.com software program is used to look at various projection scenarios. Wright County birth rates are compared to actual student enrollment and that percentage of enrollment is used to project for the next five years. This year will be using the Weighted Cohort Survival Method. Projection also looks at the housing market, economic conditions, Wright County births and open enrollment data. Projecting 5638 for K-12 enrollment for 2018-19. This number will be used for budget planning purposes.

Discussion: Reasons for open enrolling out are mainly geographic - work location, commute location and daycare. Class sizes have been mentioned although that hasn't been proven. Are other districts legally allowed to drive through our district to pick up students – yes. Marketing efforts have been put into place to hopefully reverse this trend.
