


Week of the Young Child

Research

- "The Current State of Scientific Knowledge on Pre-Kindergarten Effects" (2017)
- While all kids benefit from preschool, poor and disadvantaged kids often make the most gains.
- Features that may lead to success include "a well implemented, evidence-based curriculum" and an emphasis on the quality and continuous training of pre-K teachers.

Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)

- State-funded preschool program
- 4 year old children
- ► Eligibility factors:
 - Low family income
 - Diagnosed disability or identified developmental delay
 - Severe or challenging behavior
 - Primary home language other than English
 - Parent(s) with low educational attainment
 - Abuse/neglect of child or parent
 - Environmental risk

- Increase openings with new classroom
- September 34 slots

 January 47 slots
- For the 23/24 school year: 48 requested slots

- > 3 and 4 year old children with IEPs
- ▶ 12:45-3:45 Monday-Thursday, school year
- Curriculum is dependent on individual children's IEP's goals and objectives as well as LAP3
- Based on student numbers, ECSE teacher has been pushing into preschool classrooms to support students and teachers as a Teacher Consultant.

LONG-TERM IMPACT
