Item Name: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION AND ELECTION BALLOT FOR CASTING VOTES FOR CANDIDATE(S) TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FORT BEND CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT

Item Summary: In accordance with the Texas Property Tax Code, Section 6.03, on or before December 15th, it is required that two directors be appointed by the taxing units that participate in the appraisal district. Lamar CISD may cast all votes for one candidate or distribute them among any number of candidates on the official ballot.

Each eligible voting entity is allowed a certain number of votes per position on the ballot. Voting entitlements are based on each voting entity's percentage share of the prior year property tax levy within the county. By regulation, Lamar CISD's percentage allocation is used to calculate the number of votes the District is entitled to, which is 264 for this year.

Recommendation: Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees consider casting votes for up to two (2) candidates for appointment to the Board of Directors of the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District.
