TLR	4/29 - Tomahawk choirs were able to have a rehearsal and clinic with Dr. Shannon Gravelle, who is Director of Choral Activities at UW-Oshkosh. Dr. Gravelle led the choir through exercises to help them find healthy vocal production (singing) that is free of tension. Throughout the rehearsals, she showed the choirs several ways that they could practice strengthening their technical accuracy and their musical artistry. Dr. Gravelle critiqued the pieces that students are preparing for Solo & Ensemble festival and provided an impromptu masterclass with our mixed octet and one of our soprano soloists. Students were able to have Q & A with Dr. Gravelle about singing after high school (community & college choirs), about careers in music, and about Dr. Gravelle's own journey as a musician and an educator.
