

RESOLUTION NO. R-03-19

JOINT ELECTION RESOLUTION
Between
City of Palestine
And
Palestine Independent School District

The parties, City of Palestine and Palestine ISD, acknowledge that they will be holding an election at the same time on May 4, 2019, unless one or more of such local political subdivisions cancels its election in accordance with Section 2.053 of the Texas Election Code.

The Palestine Independent School District does hereby agree to hold a joint election under Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code with the City of Palestine that is also holding an election on May 4, 2019, in all or part of the same territory.

In the event of such a joint election, the Palestine Independent School District does hereby agree to share equally in the expense of the election such as renting and programming of voting machines. In the event of a cancelled election, due to unopposed candidates, the entity cancelling the election will not be liable for election costs incurred. Entities will have their own election workers, election ballots and ballot boxes and will vote at the following common locations:

Freedom Fellowship Church – 125 Kickapoo, Palestine, Texas
New Fellowship Christian Church – 1500 West Reagan Street, Palestine, Texas
Washington Early Childhood Center – 1020 Hamlett, Palestine, Texas
Palestine I.S.D. Administrative Offices – 1007 East Park Avenue, Palestine, Texas
Palestine High School – 1600 South Loop 256, Palestine, TX


Each political subdivision will conduct separate early voting locations for the period from April 22, 2019, through April 30, 2019.
