Subject: Create One (1) BHS Wrestling Coaching Positions

Description: Request to add 1 coaching position to the following athletic program. Browning High School 1 assistant wrestling coach.

Justification (District Goals): The following athletic program, wrestling is in need of one (1) additional coach in the wrestling program. Currently the High School has two (2) wrestling program. The coaching duties are assigned in the following order: coaches teach the fundamentals of wrestling to students in grades 9 and 12 during the season, they also teach the athletes offensive, defensive wrestling moves, holds and fundamentals. Currently having 4 coaches just isn't enough to effectively coach High School athletes. The High School has the following number of kids out for wrestling, 56, and again there isn't an effective number of coaches to coach that many athletes. Our concern is being able to effectively teach all the athletes on the wrestling team and to teach the fundamentals and techniques of each of the weight classes in wrestling. The weight classes for boys are: 103, 113, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145. 152, 160, 170, 182, 205 and HWT and for girls the weight classes are: 100, 107, 114, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145, 152, 165, 185 and HWT (max 285).

During the season the girls and boys are wrestling at the same event and there are times that there is not enough coaches to coach the matches that are going on at the same time. This new coach position would be helping with both boys and girls wrestling teams. When the teams are at different events on the same day, the head coaches will determine what event this coach would attend. During practice this coach would be at each of the practices, alternating between the practices throughout the week or day during the wrestling season.

The high school wrestling programs are continuing to grow. Currently we have 33 boys and 23 girls out for the season.
