BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Late in the day on November 19, I received a phone call from Jeff Root, Terminal Manager at the local Phillips 66 terminal. Mr. Root told me that he wanted to do something for Rolling Hills Elementary, because of their proximity, and informed me of a grant opportunity that we could submit an application for.

The grant would be for a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) Educational Project at the school in an amount up to \$25,000.

Mr. Kelley, Mrs. Brandstatt, and Mrs. Dampf and I met and decided that we would submit a grant application requesting support to purchase thirteen (13) interactive whiteboards and two (2) projectors.
