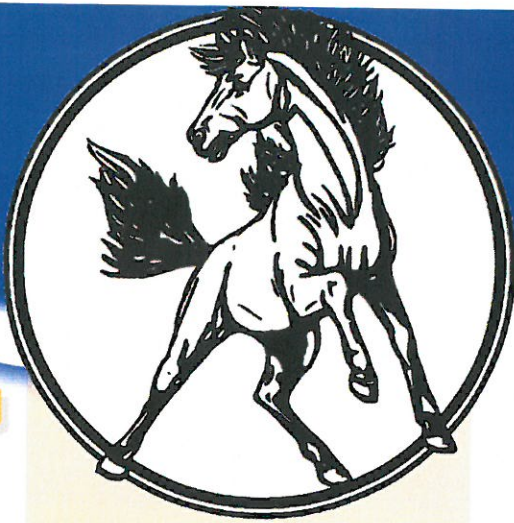

How Many Credits Can Be Earned?

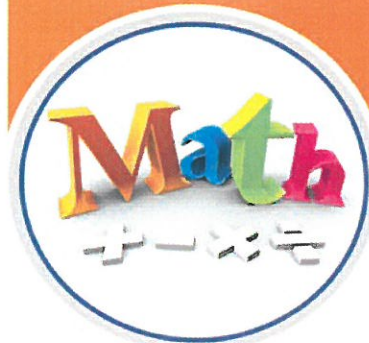
- ★ Up to 1 credit (two semesters) for credit recovery.

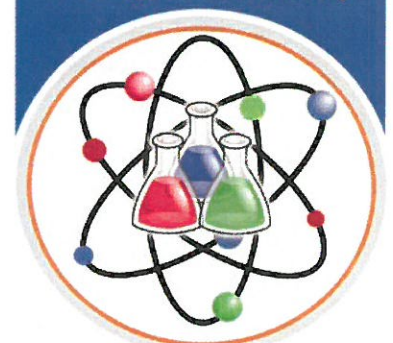


What Are The Classes Like?

- ★ Each class will make up the standards that were failed prior to summer school.
- ★ A combination of CourseWare and direct instruction will help make up the failed standards that are needed.
- ★ If a student does not complete the credit, progress of work WILL NOT be tracked to the fall due to the CourseWare license agreement.
- ★ Access to the curriculum is unrestricted, meaning students may work from home as well.
- ★ If a student has more than a half credit to make-up, the teacher determine what, where, how and if there is enough time to complete a second half credit.

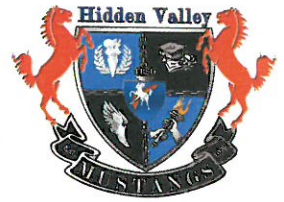
