Dear Lorna Byrne Families,

It is my delight to share with you the data from the LBMS Student Led Conferences that were held April 26th and 27th . This has been a learning experience, and has brought to light some things LBMS can work toward in the continuous improvement cycle.

I should note that while you look at the data, keep in mind that LBMS had only a 30% attendance last year during Spring conferences.

- 74.50% attendance rate, schoolwide
- 8th Grade: 77% attendance
- 7th Grade: 72% attendance
- 6th Grade: 70% attendance
- 5th Grade: 78% attendance

Also, 78 out of 81 parents that responded to our questionnaire stated their child's presentation was informative. This is indicative of the overwhelmingly positive feedback we received from you, our LBMS families, regarding this new conference format. I'm also pleased to say that the comments we received, both written and verbal, were kind, constructive, and most of all, full of praise for our staff, both certified and classified. This is most important, as it tells me that we are headed in the right direction regarding this new conference style.

In closing, I would like to once again thank each and every one of you that came out for your child's student-driven conference. It is experiences like this that prove once again, to me and the staff at LBMS, that with strong student, family, and staff cooperation, there is nothing that we can't accomplish.

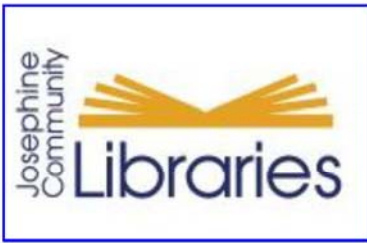

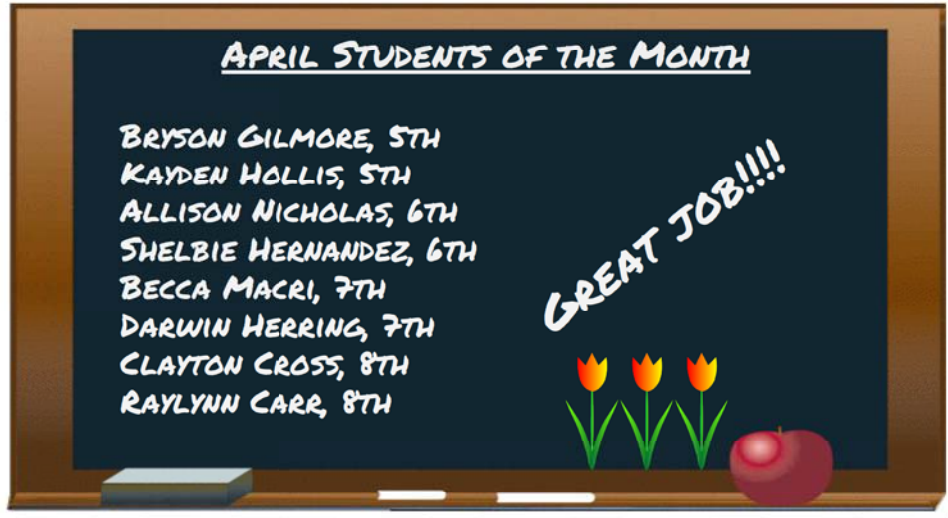

LORNA BYRNE LIBRARY POLICY

Each Lorna Byrne Student is allowed 3 books checked out for 3 weeks. If the books are returned on time or renewed before the due date, no fines accrue. If the books are not returned or renewed before the due date, then a .05¢ fine is charged for each book, each day until it is returned or renewed. If books are lost or damaged beyond repair, the student will be required to pay the replacement price. When fines reach an excessive amount and/or there is a history of lost or damaged books, students may lose their library privileges. InTouch

InTouch is used to send out important messages about school closures and school events. When you get an automated call from LBMS using this program, it is important to say "Hello" as this triggers the message to start. If you have voicemail, it will leave a message.
