Re: Purchase of UPS Battery Replacement

I would like to discuss the purchase of UPS Battery Replacement for LPS school buildings at the next Committee of the Whole meeting on Monday, March 21, 2022. I am recommending this purchase from JEM Tech Group in the amount of \$30,895.00. The purchase will come from Bond funds, and it is eligible for an approximate 50% eRate reimbursement back to the District.

UPS stands for Uninterruptable Power Supply. They are used as backup power to our buildings' networks so switches, phones, and the PA systems don't fail during a power outage in any given building. These new UPS batteries will replace the current batteries, which need to be replaced.
