November has been a busy month for special education.

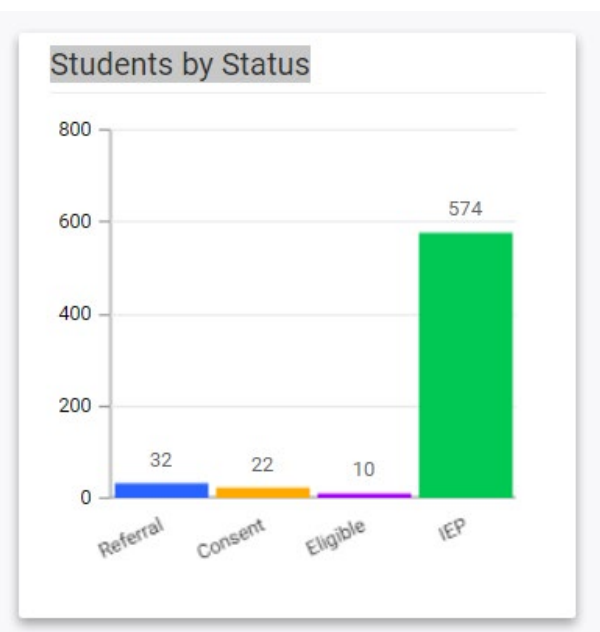
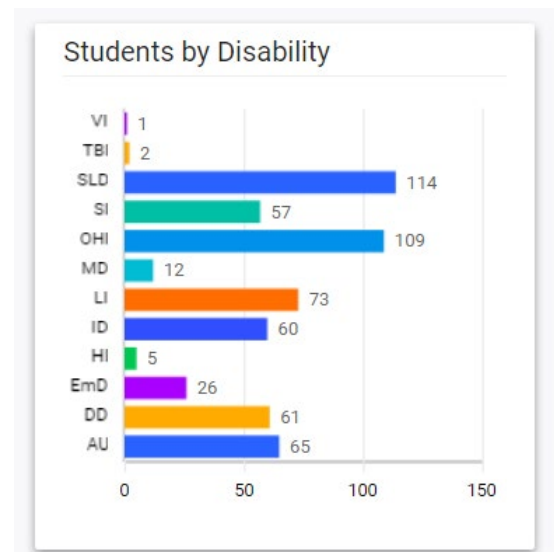
- Marsing Middle School is fully staffed with in-person services
- We have offered a contracted in-person teacher a position in Marsing Elementary (we are waiting for them to accept) to replace the online elementary teacher. If that teacher accepts we will transition the online teacher to support Homedale Middle and High School caseloads which both are currently over 40 student each.
- Online SLP has been replaced with contracted in-person SLP services for the Marsing School District
