ESL & Dual Language

We've now received ELPA results for about three-fourths of our students, and they are encouraging. There are already 37 students who have qualified for exit. We're eagerly awaiting the rest of the scores.

Testing for the Oregon State Seal of Biliteracy has now taken place and we're anticipating about 18 seniors receiving the award. They will be presented with medallions on senior signing day and then be recognized at graduation.

In the past month I have worked on and submitted the Spring EL Collection to ODE.

I have also completed writing the EL Plan that was due to ODE by the beginning of May. I'm waiting for it to be reviewed. I anticipate that, following ODE's review, there will still be a few tweaks that will need to be made, but it feels good to have it submitted.

Also, 2 staff members and a student were among the winners of the SORA reading contest in April.
