The start of June was marked by an incredible collaboration involving over 30 of our staff members, who engaged deeply with data in relation to our strategic plan. Together, we developed a robust professional development plan aimed at addressing the goals and objectives outlined in that plan. This group successfully checked off some of our goals and made valuable recommendations for the strategic planning committee meeting scheduled for August. We look forward to presenting our findings to you at the July meeting.

I want to highlight that there was unanimous agreement among the staff involved that our entire team should receive training on effectively working with families and children from different socioeconomic backgrounds.
