

All Edina District Data Metrics data points align with the Edina Strategic Plan.




District Data Metrics Plan

- 1. The District Instructional Leadership (DILT) team developed District Goals based on data from the previous year, national norms, statistical patterns of growth, and research on goal setting.
- 2. District Data Metrics Plan with demographic break down allows for a deeper analysis in order to create and/or deepen district level action steps in DILT and in individual departments.

District Data Metric Plan will be shared with the board as an update in the fall of 2024 to discuss structure and systems alignment, as well as mid-two year goal progression.

District Data Goals will be shared with the board as an update in the fall of 2025 to discuss areas of success and areas for continued growth. New goals will also be shared to ensure a targeted focus on continual progress.

District: Continuous District Improvement Plan

A Continuous Improvement Plan is the ongoing cycle of ensuring growth.

The Data Metrics Plan allows for a deeper analysis to create and/or deepen strategic plan implementation and department goals.

Each Edina District Department has responsibility for Strategic Plan Priority Strategies and the creation of C-DIP's in alignment with the comprehensive assessment plan.

Continuous District Improvement Plans: C-DIP

1. Department developed yearly goals, action steps, key indicators of progress, and metrics for measurement in alignment with the Strategic Plan, Superintendent Goals, and Data Metrics Plan Analysis.



C-DIP goals are collectively created within departments then implemented and monitored as a team on regular basis.



C-DIP goals are shared and reviewed with Superintendent Stanley three times a year.




District Strategic Plan Priority Strategies




Board partnership on initial Strategic Plan Priority work through a committee, discussion and approval process.

School: Continuous School Improvement Plan

Each Edina District School in all four grade bands is responsible for creating a building goal aligned with the comprehensive assessment plan, using building specific data.


Continuous School Improvement Plans: C-SIP

1. C-SIP's are created with collective school groups by reviewing the plan from the previous year, looking at current building data, analyzing root causes, aligning with district goals, creating a draft, gathering feedback, continuing to refine and adjust goals and action steps, beginning implementation, and continuing the process of refining and improving throughout implementation.

C-SIP's are reviewed and supported collectively at Instructional Leadership Meetings.

C-SIP's are reviewed and supported monthly with Dr. Smasal and three times a year with Superintendent Stanley.

Each PLC team is responsible for creating a PLC goal area of focus that aligns with the entire comprehensive assessment plan.

Professional Learning Community Goals

1. Every Edina Grade Level and/or Content Area meet on a weekly/bi-weekly basis to analyze data and collaborate on instructional shifts necessary to ensure Each and Every Edina student discovers their possibility and thrives. Each PLC focuses their collective inquiry on a goal area in alignment with the entire comprehensive assessment plan.



PLC goals are reviewed and supported collectively by Instructional Coaches, which includes building Principals, Assistant Principals, and Administrative Deans.
