<p><b>Kyle Luedtke</b> Superintendent</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Developing the 2025-26 school calendar based on academic needs first. PTO was able to help by providing volunteers with the elementary school on this family engagement opportunity. The event had endless breakfast, cookie and ornament decorating, time with santa, letters to santa writing and Holiday story reading. All of the letters to Santa have been responded to and sent to the student homes by “Santa” himself. We also partnered with the Village Chamber of Commerce to provide K-1 musical entertainment at the tree lighting event.</li> <li>• Last Thursday, we held the 4K-1 Holiday concert. The middle school’s attendance rate in September was 93.33% and at the end of November it was 96.45%, a 2.9% increase over last November’s rate. The high school’s attendance rate in September was 88.87% and at the end of November it was 90.27%, a 0.66% increase over last November’s rate.</li> <li>• The Fine Arts Department has been showcasing our students' talents. The middle and high school art classes from the first trimester have student projects displayed throughout the hallways. When walking around the 6-12 Building, you will see photos from the Photography class, and ‘desserts’ in the display cases from the 8th grade art class. The Winter Concert for middle and high school choirs and bands was on Monday, December 16th.
