Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that Athlos Foundation intends to submit an application to the Texas Education Agency in response to the Generation Twenty-One Open-Enrollment charter school application process. Statutory guidelines require that applicants send the enclosed *Statement of Impact* form and a copy of the completed *Application Coversheet* to each district and open-enrollment charter school that may be affected by the proposed charter school. The included coversheet indicates that Athlos Foundation intends to open three campuses over the course of the next five years. Your district or charter school is receiving this information because the proposed charter school's designated geographic boundary for the first campus or transfer boundary for all intended campuses overlaps with your district's or charter school's boundary. The proposed first campus's designated primary geographic boundary will include the following ISDs: Aubrey, Argyle, Celina, Denton, Frisco, Krum, Lake Dallas, Lewisville, Little Elm, Northwest, Pilot Point, Ponder, Prosper, and Sanger.

In addition, Athlos Foundation will have a transfer policy for all campuses whereby it may admit students residing outside of each campus's designated geographic boundary once all eligible applicants residing within the geographic boundary have submitted a timely application and been enrolled. The transfer boundary will include the following ISDs: Aledo, Allen, Anna, Arlington, Azle, Birdville, Blue Ridge, Carroll, Carrollton-Farmers Branch, Castleberry, Cedar Hill, Coppell, Crandall, Crowley, Dallas, DeSoto, Duncanville, Eagle Mountain-Saginaw, Everman, Ferris, Fort Worth, Garland, Godley, Grand Prairie, Grapevine-Colleyville, Highland Park, Hurst-Euless-Bedford, Irving, Keller, Kennedale, Lake Worth, Lancaster, Lovejoy, Mansfield, McKinney, Melissa, Mesquite, Plano, Richardson, Sunnyvale, White Settlement, and Wylie.

The attached *Statement of Impact* form provides a district or charter school with an opportunity to inform the commissioner of whether the proposed charter school may adversely impact it financially or in some other respect. Completed forms may be returned to:




