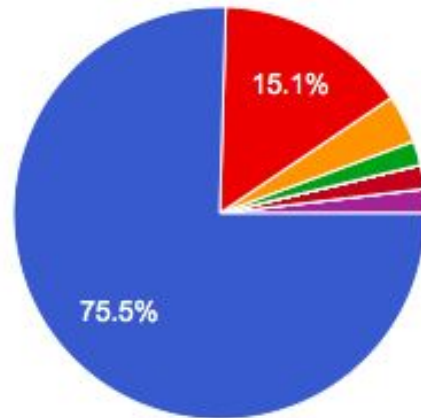

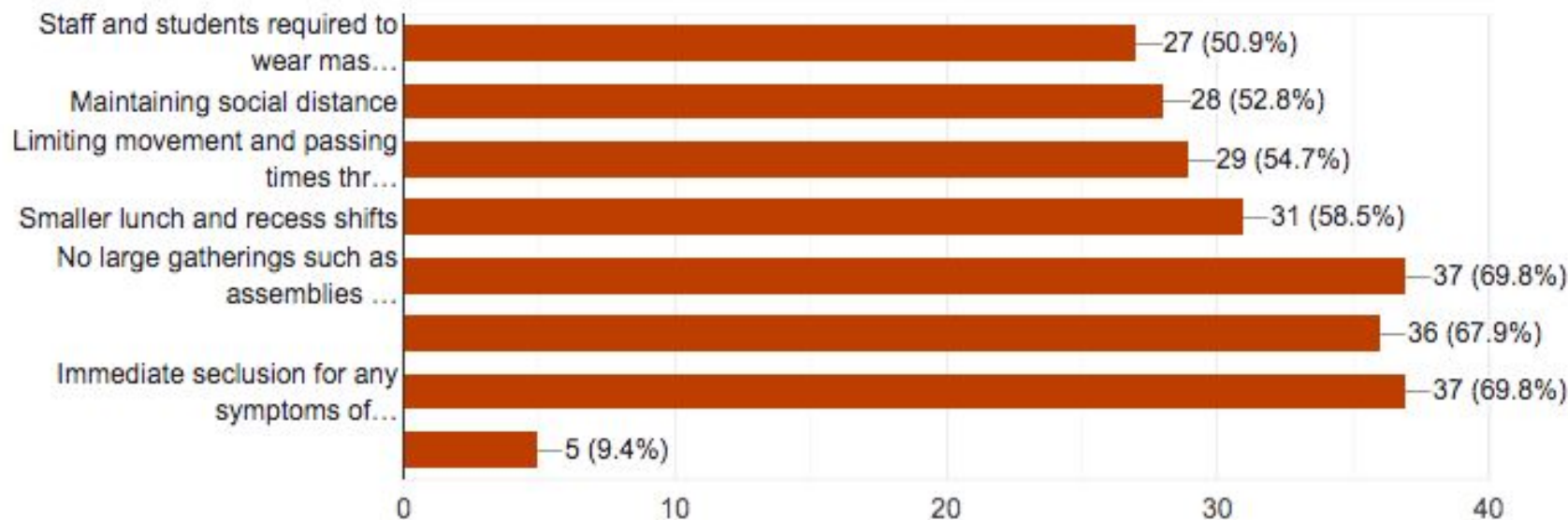

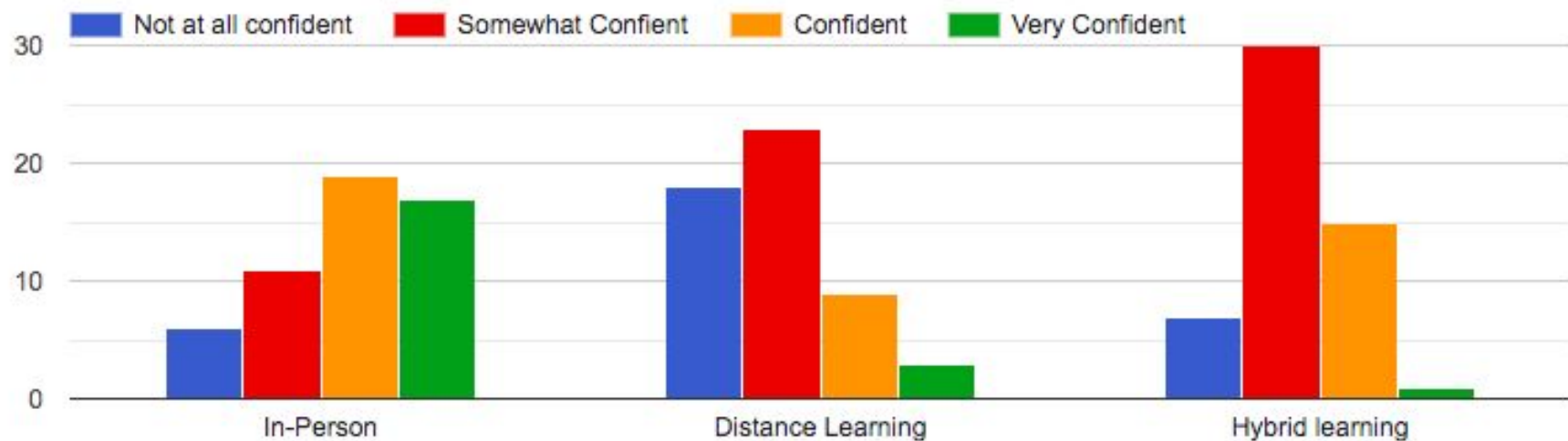
What safety measures would you need in place to be most comfortable returning to school as a staff member? Check all that apply.

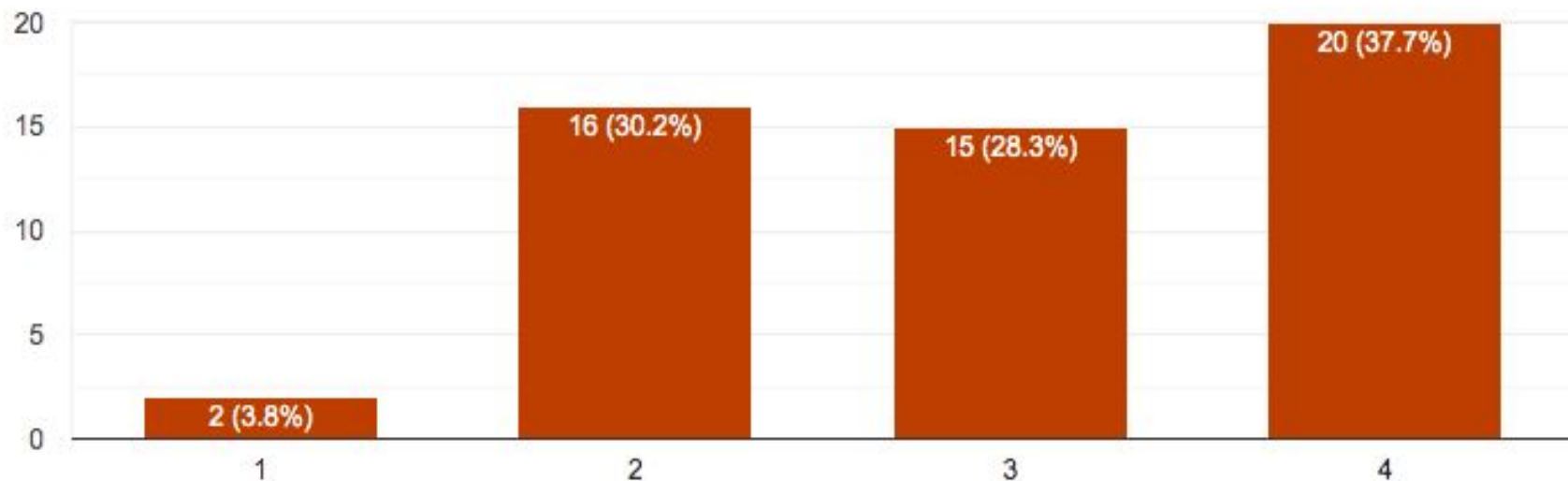
For the upcoming 20-21 school year, how confident are you that each of these options will provide a high-quality educational opportunity for ALL learners



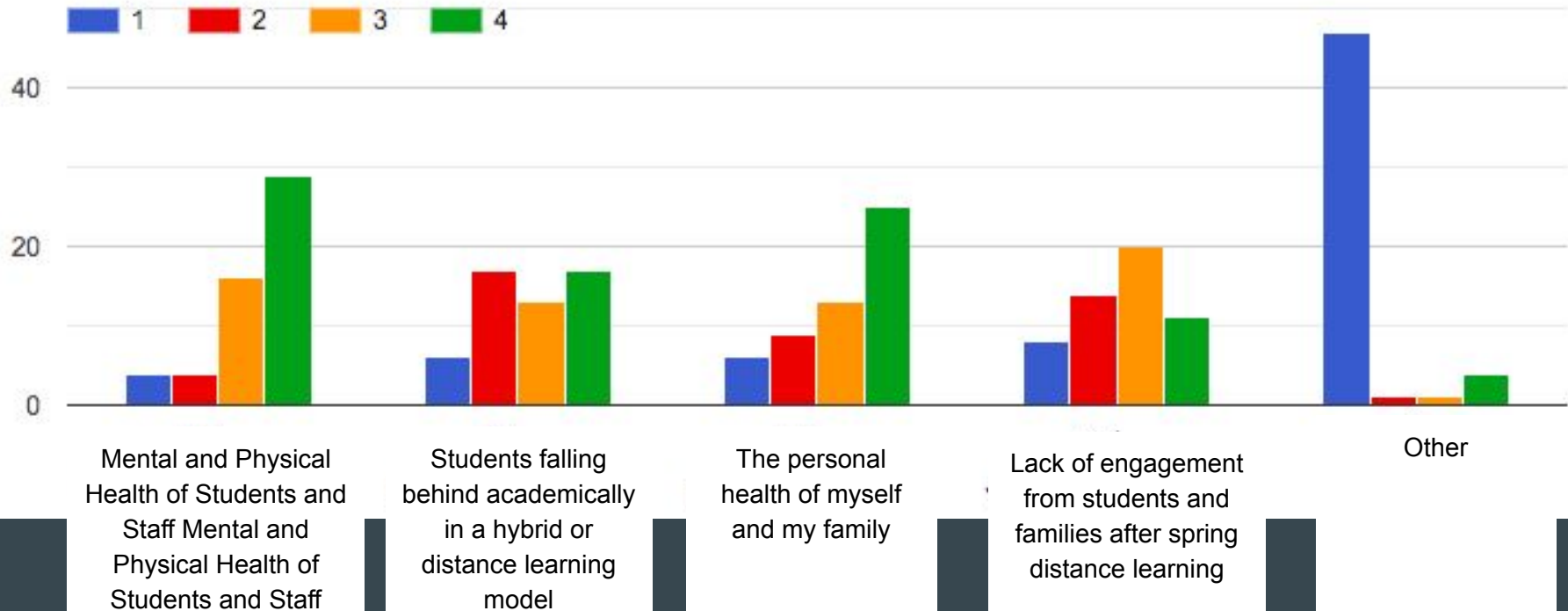
What is your level of concern that students will fall behind academically as a result of distance or hybrid learning last year if it continues into this year?

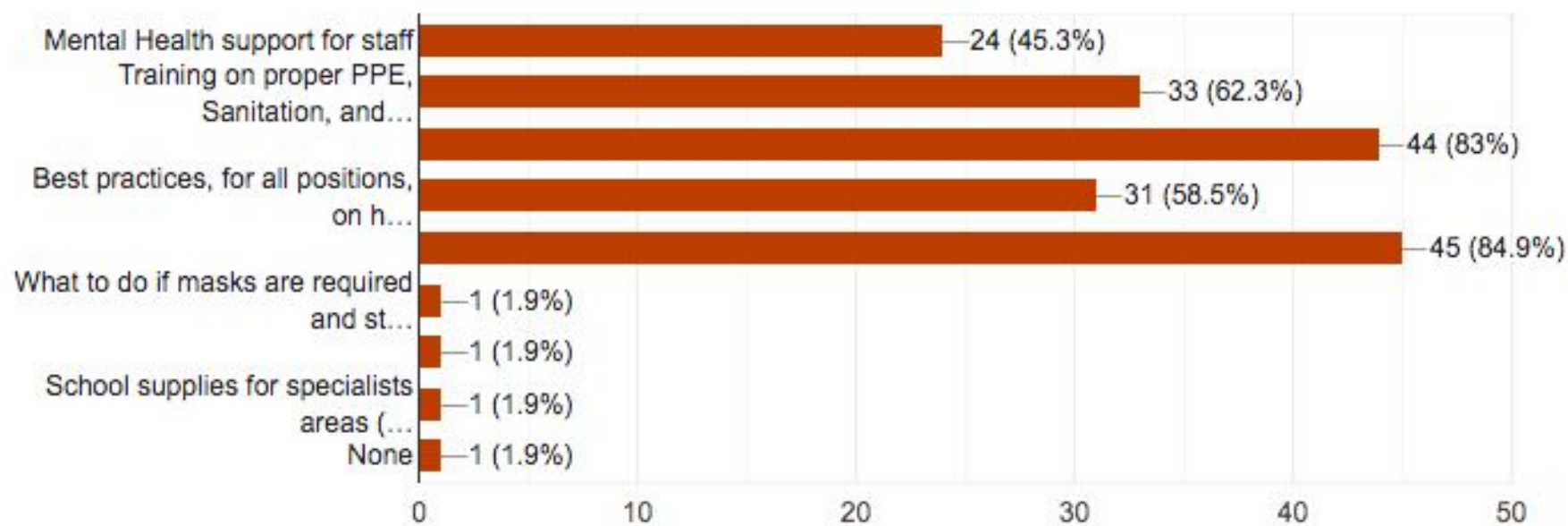
Rank the most significant concern you have about going into the 20-21 school year. 1 would be the lowest rank and 4 would be the highest

Communication on safety protocols throughout the year

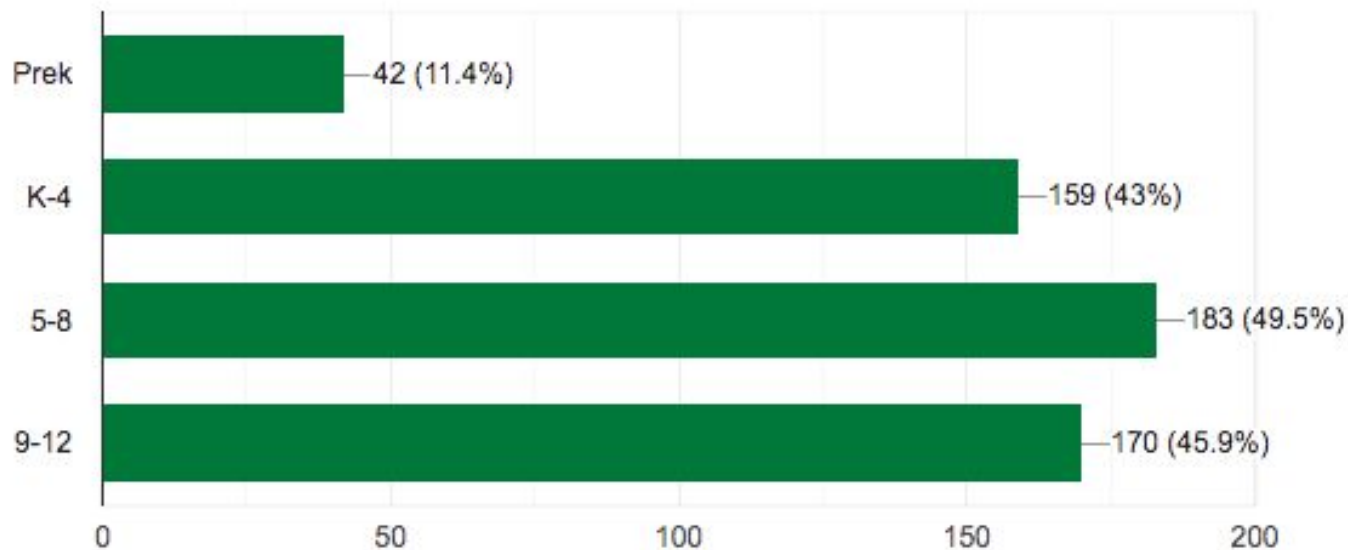
A well prepared distance learning plan in the case of a student needing to quarantine

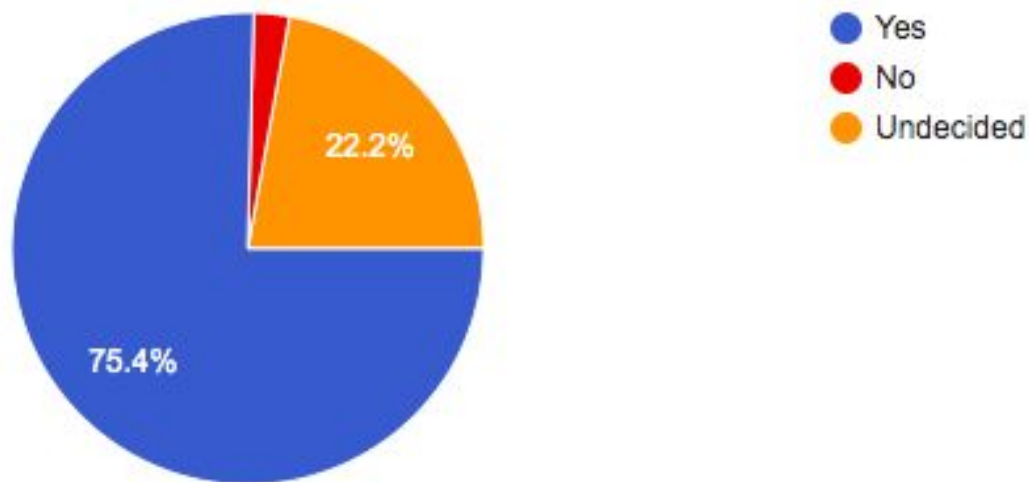
What are the ages of the children in your household who will attend WEM Public Schools during the 2020-2021 school year? check all that apply

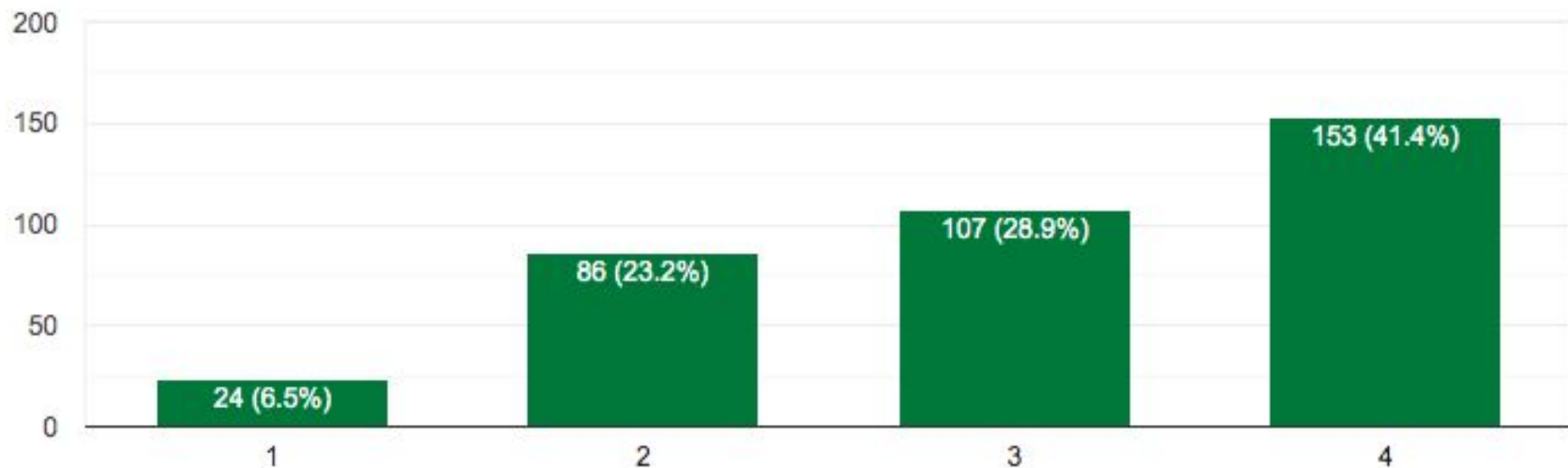

If school reopened in the fall for all students, what is your level of confidence that school will be safe for your student, based on published state guidance and additional district safety protocols that will be in place?

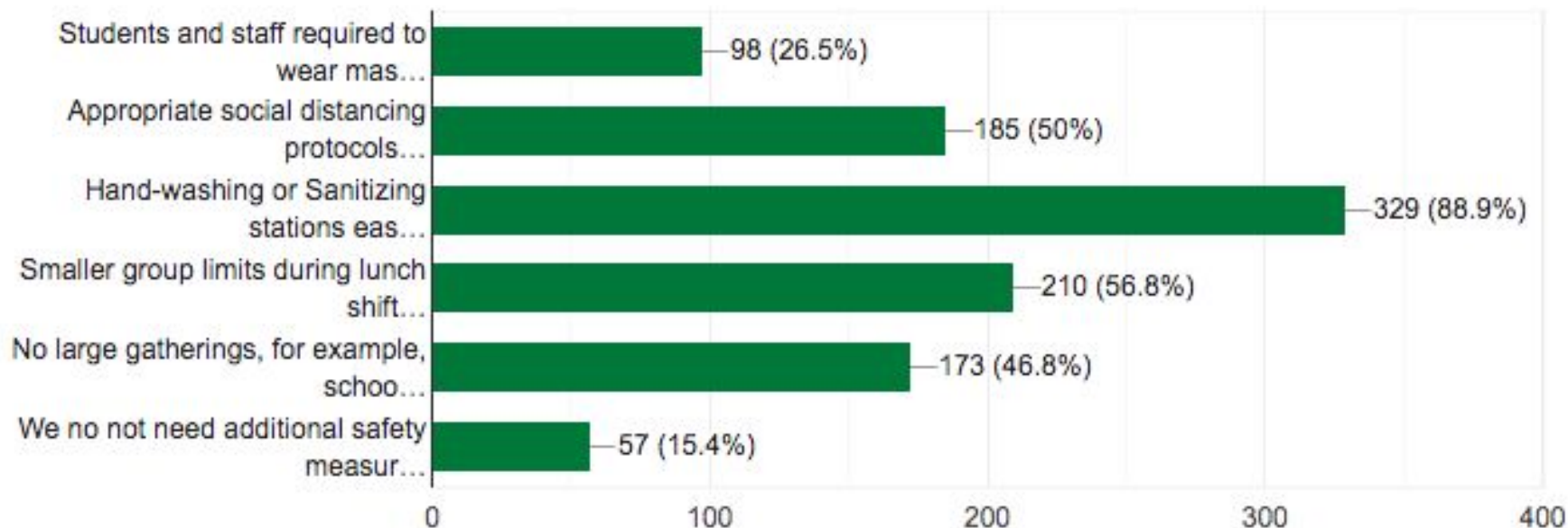

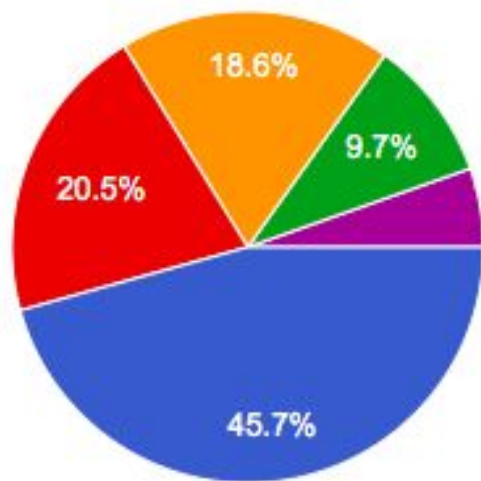
What safety measures do you feel are most important to be in place for you to be comfortable sending your child to school? Check all that apply

If reopening schools has an element of distance/online learning, what type of learning is most important to you and your student?

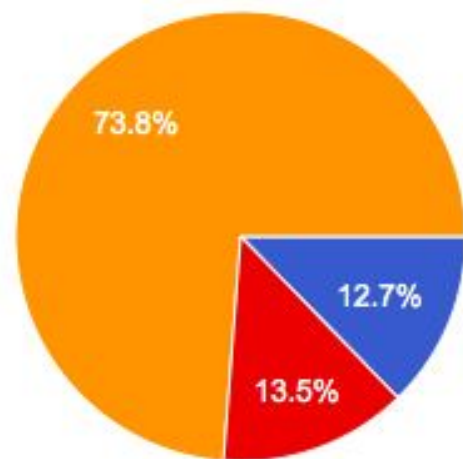

If we have another extended period of full distance learning or have a hybrid model of learning in place and your child is not in school on a particular day as a part of that model, would you continue to access the school meal program?

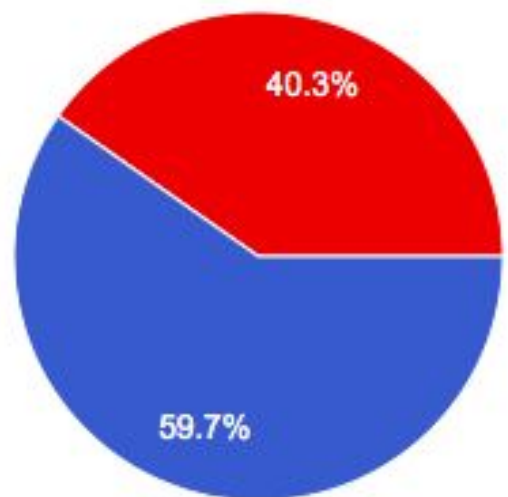

If school is able to have your student(s) come to school in the fall, do you plan to use district transportation to get to and from school daily?

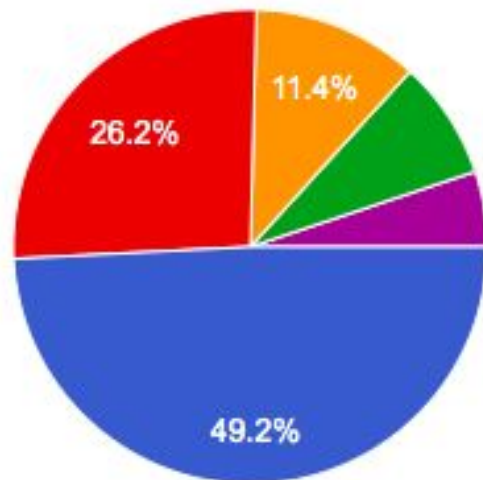
