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## PROPOSED REVISIONS

COURSE To graduate, a student must complete the courses required by the District in addition to those mandated by the state. REQUIREMENTS Students enrolled in high school prior to the 2014–15 school year **GRADUATION PROGRAMS** may graduate under state programs other than the foundation pro-**INSTITUTED** gram, including the Minimum Program, the Recommended Pro-PRIOR TO gram, and the Advanced/Distinguished Achievement Program. The 2014-15 courses required for each of these programs shall be listed in appropriate publications. The District credit requirements under these programs are listed below. The District requires no additional credits for graduation under the MINIMUM Minimum Program beyond the number mandated by the state. PROGRAM RECOMMENDED The District requires no additional credits for graduation under the PROGRAM Recommended Program beyond the number mandated by the state. ADVANCED / The District requires no additional credits for graduation under the DISTINGUISHED Advanced/Distinguished Achievement Program beyond the number **ACHIEVEMENT** mandated by the state. PROGRAM The District shall not offer state graduation credit for reading. **NO READING CREDITS FOUNDATION** The courses that satisfy District requirements under the foundation **PROGRAM** program, including courses for the distinguished level of achievement and courses for endorsements offered by the District, shall be listed in appropriate District publications. WITHOUT AN The District requires no additional credits beyond the number man-**ENDORSEMENT** dated by the state to graduate under the foundation program without an endorsement. Graduation under the foundation program without an endorsement shall be permitted only as authorized under state law and rules. The District requires no additional credits beyond the number man-**WITH AN** dated by the state to graduate under the foundation program with **ENDORSEMENT** an endorsement. DISTINGUISHED The District requires no additional credits beyond the number mandated by the state to graduate under the foundation program with LEVEL OF **ACHIEVEMENT** the distinguished level of achievement. To the extent permitted by state rules applicable to the student's **FINE ARTS** 

graduation program, the District shall award state graduation credit

The To the extent permitted by state rules applicable to the student's graduation program, the District shall allow students to substitute certain physical activities for the required award state graduation credits of in physical education for participation in approved activities and elective courses.
