a. Truth in Taxation

Funds and Property Taxes

- General Fund: Taxes
 - o 18.0000 mills for Non-Primary Residents and Commercial Personal Property
 - 7.3400 mills for Principal Residential Properties and Industrial Personal Property
 - o Debt 2017 Fund: 1.4500 mills on all property
 - o Debt 2023 Fund: 3.3100 mills on all property
 - o Debt 2025 Fund: 0.8000 mills on all property
 - o Sinking Fund: 0.6911 mills on all property
 - Food Service Fund, 2020 Non-Voted Bond Debt Fund, Expendable Trust Fund, School and Student Activities Special Revenue Fund
- Headlee Rollback

The Headlee Amendment requires a local unit of government to reduce its millage when annual growth on existing property is greater than the rate of inflation.

- Original Millage Authorized by 2020 Election: 20.000
- 2024 Millage Rate Permanently Reduced: 19:5464
- 2025 Non-Homestead Millage Reduction Fraction: 1.0000
- 2025 Millage Rate Permanently Reduced: 19.5463**
- o 2025 Millage Rate Permanently Reduced: 19.5463 mills > 18.000 mills
- Southfield Public Schools can levy 18.000 mills
- Taxable Values, Rates, and Tax Revenues
 - Current authorized millage rates: PRE 16.7543, NPE 20.000
 - Decrease in the PRE: is due to a reduction in our Hold Harmless rate
