**Subject:** Recommendation to enter into an annual agreement with ATT Inc for student hotspots and related Internet services.

# **ATT Solution:**

Seek approval to enter into an annual agreement with the option of (4) four (1) one-year annual renewals with ATT, Inc. This agreement would provide Internet and related services to our student hotspots. Our agreement with our current provider ends June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

# Justification:

While initially deployed during COVID-19 protocols to address the digital divide, school-provided hotspots remain a vital resource. A recent district survey reveals that 3.3% of our students still lack reliable internet access at home. To ensure these students can consistently reinforce and continue their learning, the district should maintain a dedicated pool of approximately 500 hotspots. Operationally using ATT Inc puts us in a very good position with one portal and one point of contact to manage out district cell phones and student hotspot services.

# **Board Policy:**

Pursuant to Board Policy 4:60, Supplies, materials, or work involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 must comply with the State law bidding procedure, 105 ILCS 5/10-20.21, unless specifically exempted.

# Recommendation:

The Board of Education should enter into an annual agreement with ATT, Inc for student hotspots and related Internet services for the hotspots. Total cost for the first year is \$117,000 to purchase 500 hotspots and monthly services. Annual renewals after year (1) are \$60,000.
