Agenda Item Caption: Consideration of Resolution of Votes Cast to Elect Directors for the Tax Appraisal District of Bell County for 2026

Purpose of Agenda Item: Action needed.

Administrative Recommendation: Move to approve the proposed resolution of votes cast to elect directors for the Tax Appraisal District of Bell County for 2026, casting the district's allocated 338 votes, as presented on the official ballot: _____ votes cast for _____.

Background Information: The Texas Property Tax Code was amended to change the process for selecting the Board of Directors (BOD) for the Tax Appraisal District of Bell County. Taxing entities within Bell County can nominate candidate(s) to be placed on the official ballot. The Board unanimously voted at the September 23, 2025, school board meeting to nominate Oliver Mintz as a candidate for the Board of Directors of the Tax Appraisal District of Bell County.

The taxing entities each have a certain number of votes to cast for the candidate(s) of their choice. Because there are two seats, there are 2,000 votes. Each entity will get a percentage of the 2,000 votes based off the percentage of the total tax levy, calculated at 338 votes for Killeen ISD. All entities must submit their votes by resolution to the Chief Appraiser.

Fiscal Analysis: None

Regulatory Requirement: Senate Bill 2 from the 88th Legislature, 2nd Special Called Session, amended Section 5.03(A) of the *Texas Tax Code* to expand the composition of the board of directors of an appraisal district in a county with a population of 75,000 or more from five directors to nine directors by adding three directors elected by majority vote at the general election. The bill establishes that appointed members of the board of directors serve staggered four-year terms beginning on January 1 of every other even-numbered year and that elected members of the board of directors serve staggered four-year terms beginning on January 1 of every other odd-numbered year.
