Service: 30 Hours

You will complete a minimum of 30 hours of community service with your chosen organization. Your advisory teacher will be asking for proof of progress at each advisory from November through March. Final Time Logs will be due on April 4th.



Presentation: DUE 5/2

Requirements for Senior Presentations:

- 5-8 Minutes in Length
- **Visual Aides**, such as photographs, PowerPoint slides, or other evidence from your time of service
- Dress Professionally

Presentations are due on May 2^{nd} , and you will be given an opportunity to practice those presentations during your Government/Economics class in May.

Final Presentations will be May 17th and 19th in front of a panel of teachers and community members.

TIMELINE

November - March: Serve a minimum of 5 hours per month. Don't get behind!
