<u>Meeting Called to Order</u>: Dr. Steve Brown, Board President, called the Board of Trustees Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

<u>Orlando, Florida</u>: Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Roy Garcia presented this item for discussion. The PHS Varsity Cheer is requesting permission for approximately 35 students to travel to Orlando, Florida from February 5-9, 2015 to compete in the National High School Cheerleading Championship. Students will miss two days of instruction and the cost of the trip will covered by personal funds.

<u>Discussion of Energy Star Designation</u>: Energy Specialists Tony Parris and Patrick Young presented this item. They reported 32 of the District's buildings achieved E-Star Rating for 2014 according to the Environmental Protection Agency standards. The District's Early Education Centers Carver and Lamar are not eligible. Bonham, Bowie, and Ector fell short of the certification mark. Cenergistic will be assisting in specifically identifying the issues at each campus in an effort to reach the certification mark in 2015.

As of October 2014, the District has saved over \$3.4 million in energy and utility cost since May 2012 when the program was implemented.

Buildings that earn EPA's Energy Star use 35 percent less energy and generate 35 percent fewer greenhouse gas emissions than similar buildings across the nation.
